## Driving Skills – Theme 3: Speed matters

### Activity 3a

### Racing scenarios

You are race drivers taking part in a series. Doing well in the race is very important to you but safety is a key priority. It is also important to follow rules and regulations to avoid penalties and possible disqualification.

- Each group works with the corresponding scenario (A, B, C see **Worksheet 3a: Racing scenarios**). Consider the scenario and decide – as a team – what you should do. Write your final decision down on your scenario paper. Time allowed: 20minutes.
- When you finish, pass your scenario paper to another group as follows:

**Group A passes on to group B**

**Group B passes on to group C**

**Group C passes on to group A**

You are now the race marshals.

- Consider the actions of the driver you review and decide if his/her actions were within the set rules and regulations. If they were not, decide on the penalty.
- Announce your decision in front of the whole class, explaining why.
