Staying in control

The law requires drivers to be in control of their vehicle at all times. What do you think this means? Write a short essay of around 500 words to explain. You may find **Factsheet 5b: Staying in control** useful. It is a good idea to do your own research as well.

Things to consider:

- handling of the vehicle
- stopping in an emergency
- ability of driver (reactions, health, drink-driving, drugs)
- feelings of passengers as a result of the driver's handling of the vehicle (Do they feel secure? Can they relax in the car? Are they scared and afraid?).
